Dear Rob,

I thought you might be interested in some very preliminary results from my field visit to Wandoan. I am still looking through field reports and receiving laboratory data, but I wanted to update you on a few quick observations:

- The approach that you are taking to environmental monitoring at Glenhaven is thorough and makes good use of the most innovative and proven technologies.
- The soil-gas and groundwater installations are well-constructed and appear to be providing high-quality data suitable for environmental monitoring.
- The soil-gas system can be well-described using a process-based approach. If a leak were to occur, it would be quickly and easily attributable using this approach.
- During the site visit, the CO₂ and O₂ sensors provided accurate results that compare well to those from the gas chromatograph. Assessment of the long-term performance of these sensors is still ongoing but the initial results are better than expected.

Overall it seems that the work you are doing at Glenhaven is well on target. Of course I will provide a more in-depth and thorough assessment within the final report.
