

CTSCo's Surat Basin Carbon Capture and Storage Project

Community Drop-in Sessions

The Surat Basin Carbon Capture Storage Project is a small-scale demonstration project being undertaken on private land 15 kilometres south of Wandoan. This grant-funded project, which is being delivered by CTSCo (a wholly owned subsidiary of Glencore) is currently still in its feasibility stage.

The purpose of this proposed demonstration project is to:

- Demonstrate that CO₂ can be safely stored in the Surat Basin through a yet to be approved test injection; and
- Provide adequate geological, environment and other scientific information to the Queensland Government to meet regulatory requirements for potential large scale CO₂ storage elsewhere in Queensland.

The CTSCo technical team will hold a community information drop-in session at the Wandoan library over a two day period. There will be no formal presentations so feel free to drop in anytime during session times listed below to find out more about the project.
